# Invitation and registration

We invite all map makers who have experience in creating O-maps and wish to further their knowledge in this field.

Entries are made via <u>ANNE</u>, no later than 01.04.2024. Guests can also register via <u>ausbildung@oefol.at</u>. The weekend is planned for approximately 15-20 people. We also invite map makers from neighboring countries, Austrian participants will be given priority as needed.

## Main topics

- Introduction
- ISOM, ISSprOM (latest changes)
- Preperation of basic data
- Testing precision of different GPS
- Field work
- Discussion of results

The goal of the fieldwork is to compare mapping styles and what are approaches to generalization and classification of objects, sharing experiences how we are digitally mapping, what equipment we use and the workflow (legend settings etc.).

# **Program**

For the education weekend, the Familienparadies Reichenhauser and the surrounding forests with an orienteering map will be available. Parts of the event will take place outdoors. **Digital** terrain mapping (PC, tablet) is a prerequisite for participation.

Luděk Krtička, a Czech expert and member of the IOF Mapping Commission, will be leading the weekend. Therefore, the conference language will include English.

Detailed information (schedule, etc.) will then be sent directly to the participants.

## Accommodation and catering options

Several options are available:

- Option 1: Half-board (incl. soup at lunch) in the <u>Familienparadies Reichenhauser</u>. Single rooms (possibly two persons in a family room with two separate bedrooms): ~ 70 € / person
- Option 2: Bed and breakfast in the <u>Hotel Sonnenhof Maria Rain</u>. Single room (~ 90 €), Double room (Single occupancy ~ 105 €, for 2 persons: 70 € / person), ~ 15 min driving by car
- Option 3: none of the accommodation options provided → self-organization

After registration in ANNE please send an email to <a href="mailto:ausbildung@oefol.at">ausbildung@oefol.at</a> with the desire for accommodation. After discussing the preferences and available options, booking will be made. No reservation of accommodation without email. First come, first serve.

For external accommodations: Lunch and dinner can be consumed at Familienparadies Reichenhauser according to the price list.

# Arrival/departure

Self-organization. Please use public transportation or organize carpooling. Public transport is available to Klagenfurt or even to Rauschelesee (800 m walk, buses run hourly on Fridays).

# Costs (for map makers from an Austrian orienteering club)

The course fee (organization, implementation, etc.) will be covered by the Austrian Orienteering Federation (ÖFOL).

Additionally, according to <u>ÖFOL-Richtlinie</u>, point 3, travel expenses to and from the event can be reimbursed. Furthermore, there will be financial support for accommodation costs (approximately 30 - 40 € per person depending on the number of participants).

#### Costs (guests)

For potential foreign participants, a course fee of 75 € will be charged, and there will be no support for travel or accommodation expenses.
