SPRINT

Agenda: First start at 14:00, after that, starts according to starting list. Free choice of starting time for the categories Beginners, Family and Direct between 14:30 and 16:00.

Time cap: 1h 30min

Distance from the competition center to the start: 5,8 km/ 20 m (marked by red-white flagging tape), clothes will be transported from the start to the competition center in case of bad weather.

Distance from finish to the competition center: 3,9 km/ 35 m (marked by yellow-black flagging tape); Immediately after the finish, please dismount and walk the trail 50 m to the bank of the river Mur (step and dangerous trail)

For both days, it is not allowed to leave marked trails with your bike, no matter if mounted or not. There will be checks off trail.



Terrain description:

The terrain splits into two very different parts. The first part is very fast paced, technically rather easy and flat terrain. There the focus will be on many parallel trails sometimes close to each other. It will be easy to miss a turn or pick a wrong trail. The trails there were previously covered with knee-high grass and have just been mowed making them very fast. After the crossing the river Mur at the lock with some sharp turns the part north of the river Mur begins. There you should expect technically challenging trails (roots, rocks), especially along the river. The terrain there is also flat with some small inclines. Only the two longest courses cross the rail tracks twice and have some steeper parts. There are some very narrow bridges which do not allow for passing other cyclists. They can be quite slippery when wet. There are also some parts with poor vision due to dense foliage. On the map you will also find some restricted areas with beehives. Those are marked on the map and should not be crossed under any circumstances. Due to heavy rainfalls recently vegetation has grown tall in some places. Some areas such as critical turns have been mowed due to this.

There are a few portable hunting stands with frequently changing locations which are therefore not mapped.

Finish: there is a silent finish in the middle of the woods. The distance to the competition center from there is about 4 km, the route is marked with yellow-black flagging tape. About 200 m after the finish there is a narrow, very steep trail down to the river Mur. **It is mandatory to unmount for this and walk the 50 m to the bank of the river.**

Downloading your SI stick data will be done at the competition center.



MIDDLE DISTANCE

Agenda: First start at 10:00, after this starts according to starting list. Free choice of starting time for the categories Beginners, Family and Direct between 10:30 and 12:00.

Time cap: 2h 30min

Distance from the competition center to the start: 4,3 km/ 20 hm (marked by red-white flagging tape). Clothes will be transported from the start to the competition center in case of bad weather.

The finish is at the competition center.

Terrain description:

A flat part of the woods with mostly easily passable trails from the start. Seasonal growth of vegetation is at its peak though. The longer courses go into a dense network of trails with different passability. Especially the elite categories will have to choose between looking at the map or on the bumpy single trails. There will be some parts tough on your legs with some tricky controls before you'll finish at the stadium. Some courses cross the rail tracks. Places for crossing them are clearly marked as such in the map. Crossing the rail tracks outside the marked areas is forbidden and very dangerous. This rail line is the heavily used connection to the south.

There are a few portable hunting stands with frequently changing locations which are therefore not mapped.

Rules for both days are that leaving marked trails is not allowed. There will be checks off-trail to enforce this.

AWARD CEREMONY

for ÖM/ÖSTM Sprint at the competition center on Saturday at about 18:00.

for ÖM/ÖSTM middle distance at the competition center on Sunday at about 13:30.

COMPETITION CENTER

The football and athletics stadium will be available on both days exclusively. Registration will be south of the tribune on the first floor. We kindly ask you to send **one** representative per club.

Changing rooms, showers and toilets: those are on the ground floor and on the first floor of the tribune building. Please respect the signage.

Bike cleaning: On the ground floor (east side) of the stadium there will be two pressure washers.

The athletic track and the football field must not be accessed with bikes.

FOOD / DRINKS

Cafeteria of the local football club FC Judenburg at the competition center on the first floor.

There will be a choice of different hot and cold dishes and drinks. Please make use of this offer as the event is strongly supported by the city of Judenburg and the football club FC Judenburg.

CHILD CARE

Will be offered at the competition center near the bike park.
Saturday from 13:30,
Sunday from 09:30, both days until the last finish time.

TRAINING EMBARGO

There is a training embargo at the competition area. It is not allowed to enter this area other than on public roads and marked bike paths.

DANGERS

The area is also frequently used by hikers, runner and others. We kindly ask you to be considerate, especially at narrow passages. There are also some beehives in the competition area. Those areas are marked as no-access and it is not allowed to enter those parts of the map. In the terrain the trails will be marked with flagging tape at the edges of those restricted areas but not blocked off.

FURTHER DETAILS

This event is organized according to the competition rules of the Austrian Orienteering Federation. The organizing club is not responsible for any harm, damage or injury, as well as eventual claim towards third parties. Every runner participates at one's own risk.

The provisions of the Road Traffic Regulations and the Austrian Forest Act need to be followed. It is mandatory for all participants to wear a helmet. In case of the event's cancelation neither the Austrian Orienteering Federation nor the organizing club will cover any incurred expenses.

By registering to these competitions, the rider agrees to the publication of any photograph taken by the organizers during the competition as well as the online publication of the result list as well as the starting list including name and year of birth (see also DSGVO-Attachment).



EXTRORDINARY MEASURES DUE TO COVID-19-PANDEMIC

The event has been designed such that on the entire area, especially at the competition center, distance can be kept easily. Signs will be installed at all points inclined to cause a gathering. All activities before and after the competition including the award ceremony will be held outdoors. Access to the changing rooms, showers and toilets will be regulated such that participants can keep enough distance. Sanitizer will be provided at areas with surfaces or objects touched by different people as well as in changing rooms and showers. Serving of food and drinks is exclusively provided by the cafeteria of the FC Judenburg. Special attention will be paid to make sure cafeteria guests will keep proper distance.

Snacks at the finish can only be served in a way which will be allowed at the time of the event. There will be no other places where snacks are handed out especially not on course, this has to be organized by the athletes themselves. To facilitate the tracing of contacts in the case of a Covid-19 case, a form to register all accompanying persons which are not participating as well will be provided. Please fill this out for your entire club and hand it over at registration when picking up starting information.
